

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The principles which guide the activities of the Son Matias Beach Hotel in Palmanova are based on a growing and continuous respect for the environment as well as fulfilment of current environmental regulations and any other relevant requirements.

The prevention, assessment and control of the impact of the Hotel's activities on the environment are at the core of all its activities, thus contributing towards global environmental policies from a local standpoint.

Such principles of prevention, assessment, control, continuous improvement and fulfilment of legal environmental regulations are therefore applied as follows:

- Reduction, reuse and recycling of generated waste, in the said order of priority and with controlled management of end product.
- Reduction in consumption of water, power, fuel and other consumables, all selected according to environmental criteria.
- Reduction in the polluting volume and load of sewage, and subsequent reuse and recycling thereof in said order of priority.
- Reduction in volume and load of air pollutants and reduction of noise.
- Use of the land protecting it from contamination and negative impact on surrounding areas.
- Delivery of services and performance of activities with utmost respect for the environment.
- Selection of suppliers and subcontractors according to environmental criteria.
- Prevention of potential environmental adverse effects in the event of emergencies.
- Information and training on environmental issues for staff, guests and external agents.

Awarded only to hotels who continually maintain a high standard of quality control.

This commitment to the environment is put into practice via the environmental management system ISO 14001/2015, about which all employees have knowledge and is subject to review on an annual basis during the performance of the "management review".
